

The members actively participated. They nominated and voted for their own choice.










Finally, a new set of officers were elected.

The perseverant SHINe Info team was eager to finish the bulletin board.










After a long time of work, it all paid off by having a wonderful bulletin board at the side of Mrs. Infantado's room.

We prepared slides presentation about the progress of SHINe in our school and the SHINe president led this presentation.










Engr. Hernando, also prepared a presentation and suggestions for the continuous growth of SHINe in our school.

A representative from Baggao and the ShiNe Coordinator shared some of important informations.






Engr. Hernando and Mr. Rodriguez gave the closing remarks.



This implementation flow chart will be followed and executed everytime a light/ heavy rain, and/ or typoon visit the area.

### RAINFALL OBSERVER

- Reads, analyzes and sends rainfall reading, and other informations to the encoding/ transmitting and info board teams







### ENCODING/TRANSMITTING INFORMATION TEAM

-encodes, and sends rainfall readings and other important informations to the PDRRMC office
-Sends collected informations to the Inspecting Team (IT)

### **INFO BOARD TEAM**

-Displays the rainfall readings and other vital informations in the ShiNe bulletin board



### **INSPECTING TEAM**

- -Roam around and inspects the condition of the school and its nearby areas after the occurence of a light/ heavy rain and/or even typhoon
  - sends the recorded information to the Action Implementing Team (AIT)

### **ACTION IMPLEMENTING TEAM**

-Make necessary actions regarding the forwarded informations of the Inspecting Team
 - Forwards request of monitoring and evaluation to the Monitoring/ Evaluation
 Team (EMT) after completing the actions needed for the forwarded information

### MONITORING/ EVALUATING TEAM

-Monitors the conduct of implementing the necessary actions
-Evaluates the effectiveness of the actions executed by the AIT
\*If in case the actions were not found effective, the AIT will be
requested again to make and try other possible solutions to
the informations and problems forwarded by the IT

\*\* if the solutions were found to be effective the EDUCATION
COMMITTEE will be addressed to keep the records of possible
solutions for future references.
