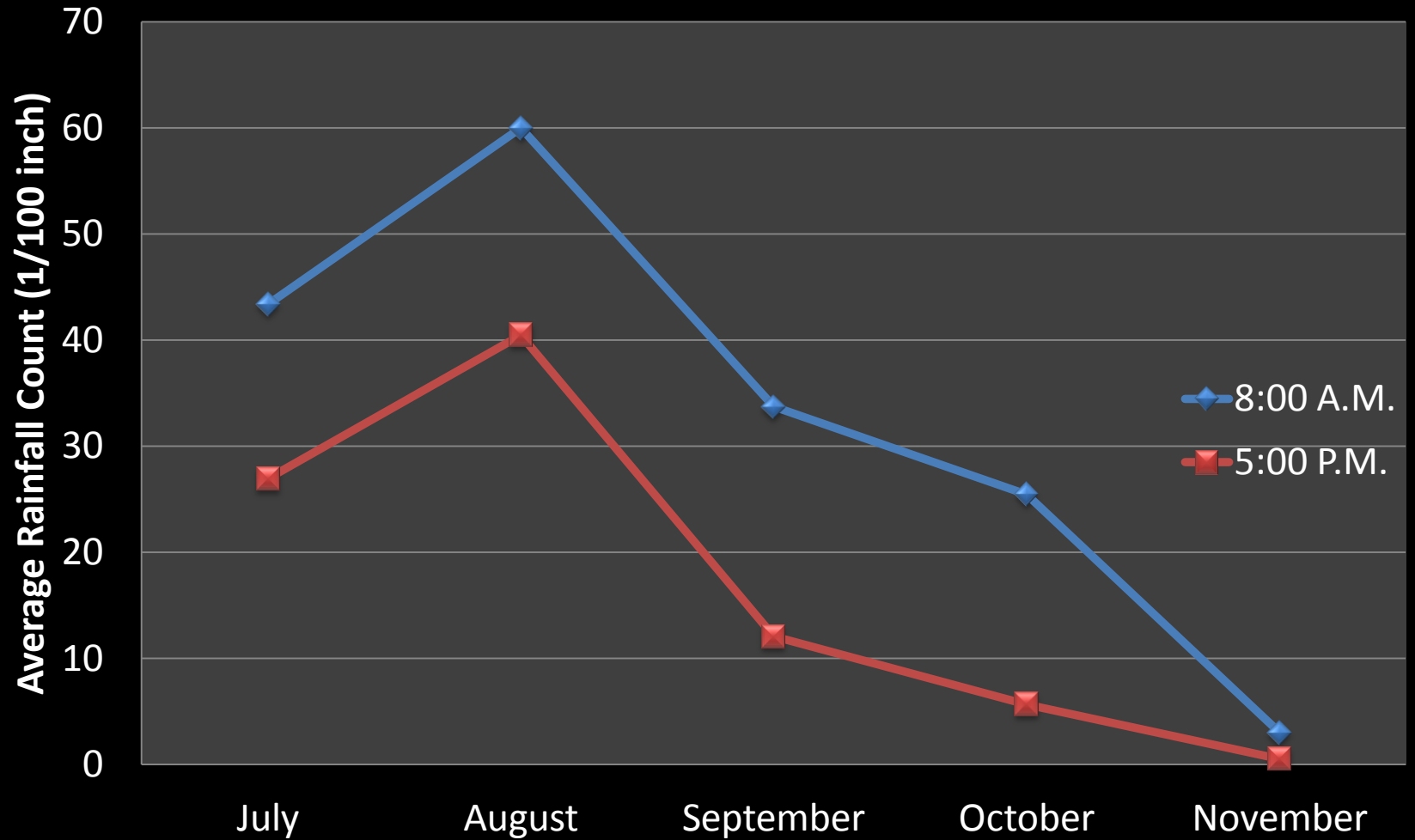

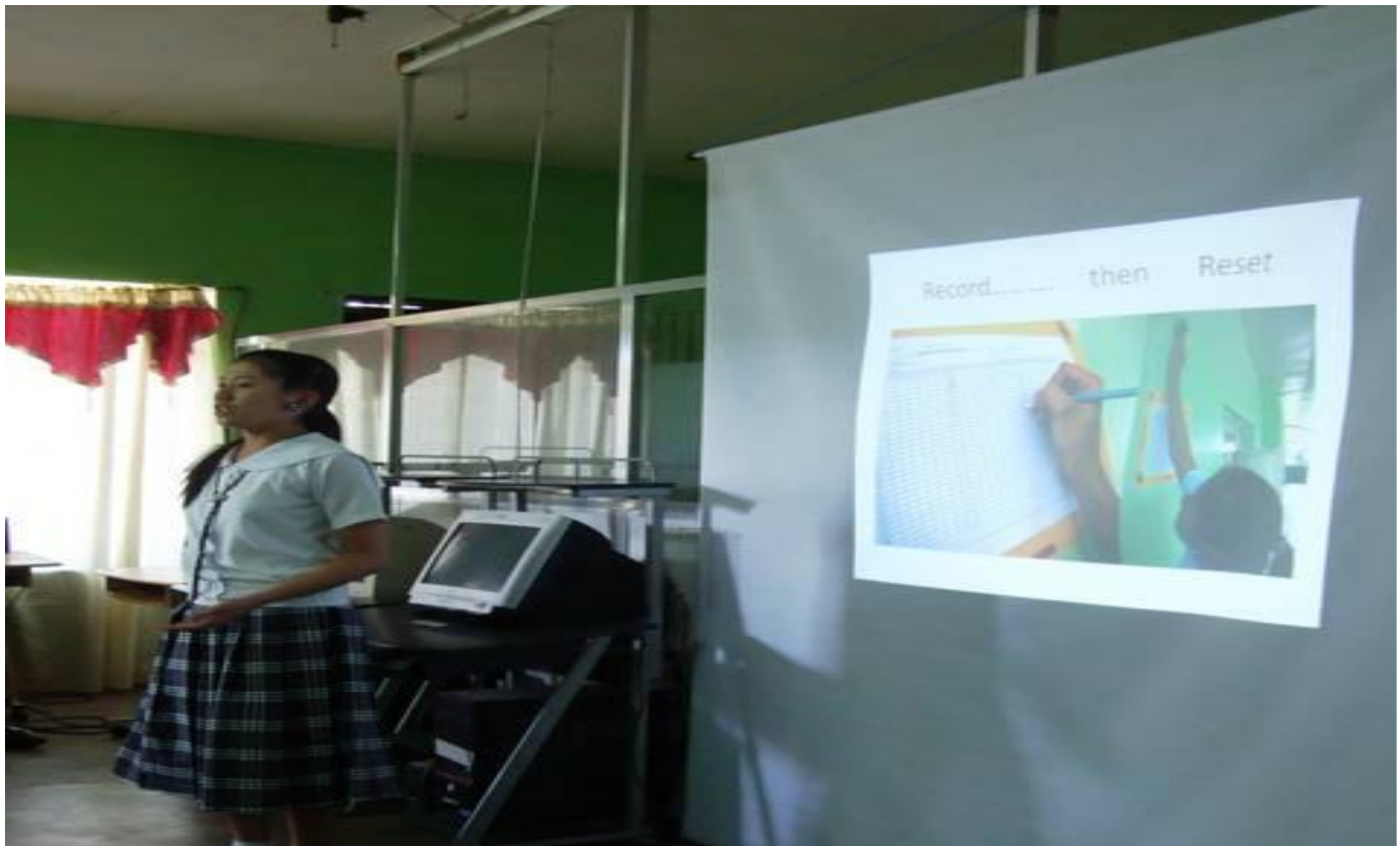


OBJECTIVES

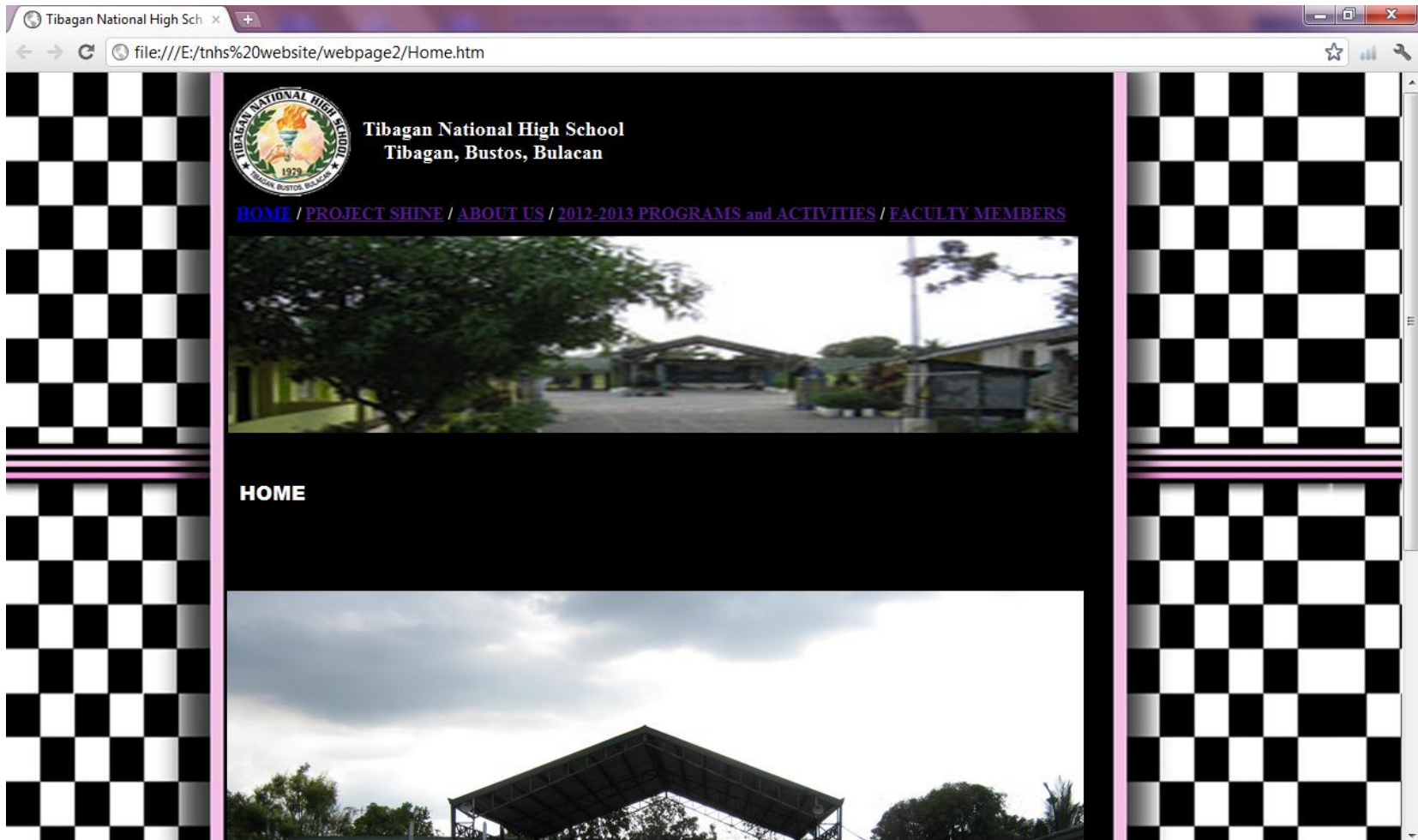
